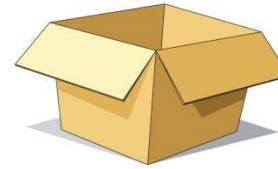


1. Find a small cardboard box. Turn it on its side with the opening facing away from the child.



2. Place between four to six familiar noisy items in the box, such as, a set of keys; a crispy packet; a squeaky toy; a bell; etc...



3. Whilst placing them in the box, show them to the child and demonstrate the sound that each item makes.



4. Ask the child to listen attentively and use one of the items in the box to produce a sound.

5. Invite the child to guess what the item is.
